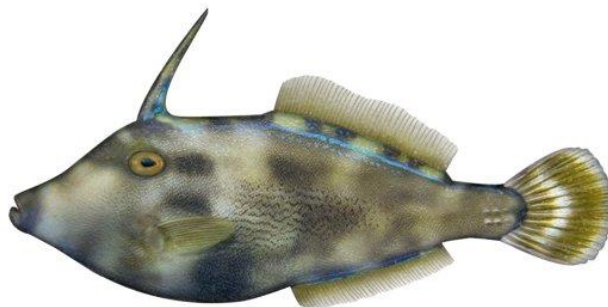

FISH OF THE MONTH June - LEATHER JACKET



Several features set Leatherjackets apart from other fish species, these include: a small mouth with beak-like teeth, rough sometimes sandpaper like skin, small gill openings, and a single serrated spine on the top of the head that fits neatly into a groove. Most Leatherjackets are considered opportunistic feeders and readily feed on many different items including algae, crustaceans, molluscs, fish and polychaete worms.

A bit of berley and a variety of baits such a squid, prawns and pipis will see plenty of attention from leatherjackets.

On the offshore reefs, leatherjackets bite aggressively and are usually much bigger in size and easier to hook. For these fish, the standard offshore paternoster rig is ideal. If they are around in big numbers though, it can be worth changing to one of those commercially-available wire paternoster rigs, as it will save you from lots of bite offs (leatherjackets tend to bite at any scraps of bait anywhere on the line).
