

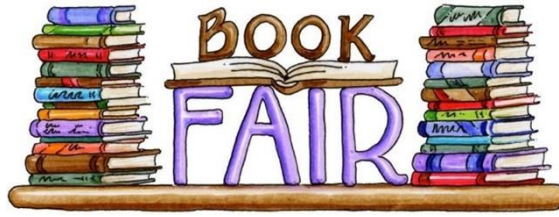
All fish must be legal length and measured from TIP OF SNOUT TO TAIL FORK.

Except for Dusky Flathead, Mulloway, Gummy Shark, Leather jacket, Red Rock Cod, Sand Flathead, Tiger Flathead and Wrasse which is TOTAL length.

Fish must be photographed on a DPI brag mat and photos are to be brought with you for verification of the length and time date of capture at our Clubhouse on Sunday 23rd October 2022.
