JULY 9th

our ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING was held where limited numbers attended. Unfortunately main postions of the committee were unfilled. Role of President saw Wayne Holding accept and Vice President was filled by Eddy Evans.

A special general meeting was scheduled for Saturday July 29th prior to our annual fish awards presentations to fill the vacant positions of secretary and Treasurer.

The AGM resulted in the change to Clause 50 Weight Recording in our 21/3/21 constitution to be replaced with the following.

Clause 50: Club Competitions and Recording:

- All LEGAL fish will be recorded by length only and must be measured by being placed on a DPI brag mat and photographed to clearly show the snout touching the zero end of the mat and the tail as near as possible to the center of the measurement scale on the mat. The photo must show the date of capture and be presented within two months of that date.
- For species with forked tail, the measurement from the tip of the snout to the fork of the tail will be recorded.
- Fish with a rounded tail to be measured from the tip of the snout to the tip of the tail.
- When photographing a fish members will need to ensure that it complies with the weighmasters requirements before they release it or cut it up as weighmasters may reject a non- compliant photo. Members will also be expected to check the latest fish weights sheet for current leading lengths before submitting a claim.

Club Records:

- The club proposes to commence a new register of records based on lengths. While this would mean that a record could be claimed for a small fish, members will be asked not to make frivolous claims just to be a record holder for a short time.
- To preserve the historical weight based records, this register will remain open for members who choose to use it in the event they make a record breaking catch.
- Members will be required to submit a claim for a record accompanied by a compliant photo for the new length register, or a weight slip from a recognized weigh station for the old weights section.
- Prior to submitting a claim for a weights record, members will be required to consult the old weights register to ensure their claim is valid.
- If the fish is deemed a new club record it can be recognised as both weight and length.

Advantages of adopting these changes.

- Allows recording and release of all of our target species.
- Removes the need to find a weigh station to record a catch (except for the record weights register)
- Removes the need for weigh masters to convert length to weight from the DPI brag mat conversion tables.

The committee hopes that through the adoption of these changes more members would be encouraged to enter their catches in the club`s competitions leading to an enhancement in their enjoyment of the sport and an overall increase in interest in fishing throughout the Club.

Annual Species Changes

Consideration was given to ammend bringing in line species that are measurable.

July 29th SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING, welcomed dedicated life member Debbie Cummings accept the role of secretary and we still require a treasurer. Post meeting Val Cartledge has offered once again to be acting Treasurer *until someone else offers or can be sourced*.
