Here is Val's recipe for when you catch the Bream, it is actually a low fat recipe, you can adjust it to ordinary if you wish.

FISH ALASKA Serves 4

4 x 120g pieces Bream

1 tablesp low fat margarine

1/2 cup chopped shallots

1 heaped tablesp plain flour

1 tablespoon chopped parsley

1/2 cup skim milk

1/2 cup white wine

1 can drained crab meat (optional)

1 cup grated reduced fat cheddar cheese.

Salt & pepper to taste.

SAUCE: Melt margarine in medium size saucepan, stir in flour with a whisk. Slowly add milk, stir constantly to avoid lumps. Add wine, shallots, parsley and drained crab meat, mix well.

Salt & pepper to taste.

Cook fish fillets in a non-stick fry pan that has been generously coated with cooking spray turning once.

Once cooked place fish on a flat baking tray that has been coated with cooking spray, spoon sauce evenly over each piece. Sprinkle 1/4 cup cheese over each piece of fish.

Grill until golden brown. Serve with salad.
